

Efficacy of Homoeopathic Remedy in the Treatment of Prolapse of third eyelid in street dog: A case report

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Abstract

Prolapse of third eyelid is common disease among dog and in modern medical science there is only surgical treatment is available for treating such disease with high recurrence chances. Homoeopathy is very unique medical science which was discovered by Dr Samuel Hahnemann in 1796 and this science has been based on some basic concept for treatment of living organism that is *similia similibus curantur*. Homoeopathy (Overall, 2009).has very good affinity in case of animals' especially surgical disease (Dugan,1992). One a case street dog was suffering from prolapse of third eye lid since 3 months. It was observed and given suitable homoeopathic medicine to this dog (Raza,2013).

Results

Taking objective symptoms of this dog homoeopathic medicine for prolapse of third eyelid was prescribed and within 20 days the case recovered.

A street dog (age is unknown) to the dockyard was observed with the protrusion in its eye (which eye) medial side with lacrimation from same eye.

The case was diagnosed as Prolapse of third eyelid.

The following symptoms were observed with a affection of inner surface of the eyelids. yellowish discharges from the

eyes, saccular conjunctiva (Phatak,2010) and paralysis of the muscles of the eyeball.

Treatment:

The case was treated with RHUS TOXICODENDRON 30 3 DOSE, orally Follow-up after 20 days showed no red mass in medial side of eye. The dog was observed for 6-7 month but there was no recurrence of these symptoms

Conclusion:

After observing this condition in street dog and the diagnosis with help of veterinary surgeon. In conclusion that there was a definitive role of homoeopathic medicine in this condition when objective clinical symptoms were taken and prescribed homoeopathic medicine "RHUS TOXICODENDRON 30CH" 3 doses was given and follow-up was taken after 20 days there was no prolapse in eyelid and this case was observed for 6-7 month and there was no recurrence of this condition.

Discussion :

After observing this condition in this dog and diagnosis with help of veterinary surgeon of this condition and come to conclusion that there is definitive role of homoeopathic medicine in this condition as same time objective clinical symptoms are taken and prescribed homoeopathic medicine "RHUS TOXICODENDRON 30CH" 3 (Phatak, 2010) dose Orally was given and follow-up was taken after 20 days it's really surprised that there was no prolapse in eyelid and observed this dog for last 6-7 month and no recurrence of this condition.
